## Let's talk NATO: Frendo calls for Constitutional rethink

KARL SCHEMBRI FORMER Foreign Minister Michael Frendo has called for a rethink of Malta's relationship with NATO and for constitutional changes that would do away with the "passé terminology defining 'neutral-. Writing on MaltaToday, Frendo confirms the decision to join the contentious Partnership for Peace was taken just in the wake of the election as it was never decided under his responsibility.

However he says he agreed "fully" with the government's decision to reapply for mem-bership into the NATO-led initiative, scrapped by Alfred Sant's government in 1996.

In line with rejoining Partnership for Peace, in my opinion, the time has come for a serious unemotional debate to be carried out on Malta's general relationship with NATO since, post-Cold War, this organisation has a changing collective security role also espoused by many nonmember countries such as, for example, Russia and Algeria," Frendo writes.
