Gozo airstrip: Labour's environment U-turn

JOSEPH Muscat's Labour party is actively considering an airstrip in Gozo for fixed-wing aircraft as an option to improve connectivity between the two islands.

Stopping the application for the Gozo airstrip was one of Alfred Sant's first decisions as prime minister in 1996, after

withdrawing the country from NATO's Partnership for Peace programme.

Now, a Labour government led by Muscat is promising to do the opposite. "The development of an airstrip is one of the options a Labour government would consider to ensure better connectivity between Malta and Gozo," Labour spokesperson for planning Rod-erick Galdes told MaltaToday.
