

This time it is Mario Debono, vice president representing the pharmaceuticals sector, to have suspended himself from the chamber's council pending investigations into a case of illicit importation of unlicensed drugs, MaltaToday can reveal.

The police are to arraign Debono on criminal charges before Magistrate Antonio Mizzi on Tuesday.
